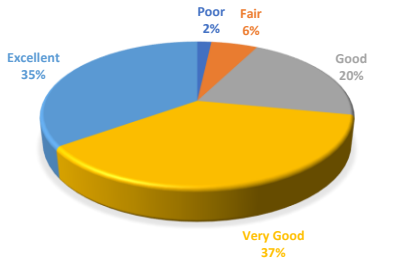

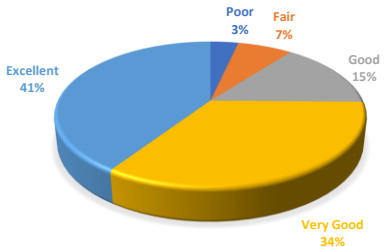

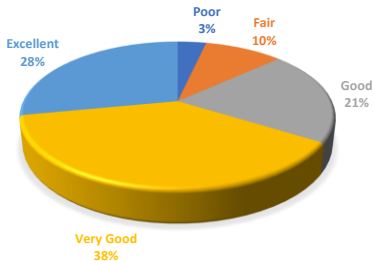

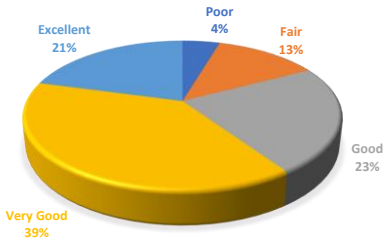

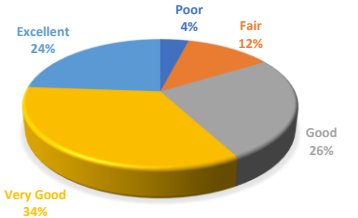

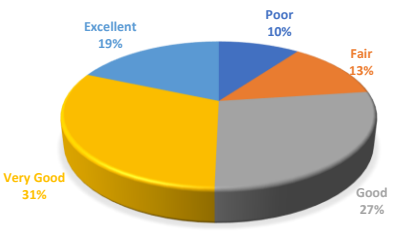

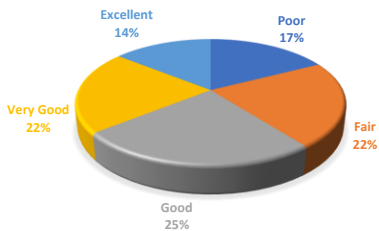
#### 8. LIGHT AND VENTILATION IN THE CLASS ROOMS



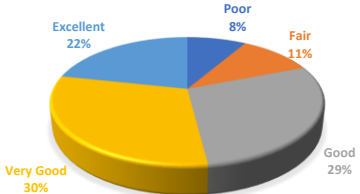

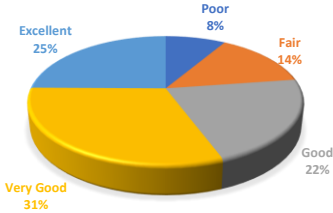

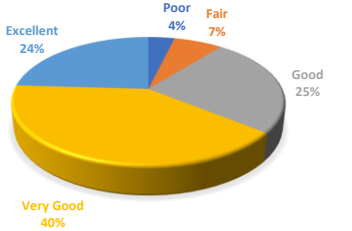
