State Level Workshop "Preparation of Research Proposals and Financial Approval of Research Projects" was held on 29/01/2019, organized by IQAC, Govt. College Hansi, Sponsored by Higher Education Department, Haryana. There were in total 160 participants including teachers, research scholars, academicians etc., across the state of Haryana, making the workshop a grand success.



The event was graced by the elegant presence of the speakers, **Dr. R.K. Uppal**, Head of Department of Economics, D.A.V. College Malout (Pb), **Professor Sanjeev Agarwal**, Department of Physics, Kurukshetra University Kurukshetra and **Dr. Mani Shreshtha**, Faculty, Haryana School of Business, Guru Jambheshwar University of Science and Technology, Hisar



The event started at 9:00 a.m. and registration desk was opened up to 10:00 a.m. The event was ceremoniously inaugurated with the lamp lightening ceremony by the chief guest and keynote speaker Dr. R.K. Uppal, Principal Smt. Savita Mann, Vice Principal Dr. Pardeep Verma and Workshop Coordinator Dr. Raj Kumar.

The event was effectively anchored by Dr. Harsha, Organizing secretary of the workshop. A formal welcome address was delivered by the Principal Smt. Savita Mann. The workshop coordinator presented a detailed overview of the scope and objectives of the workshop.



The first resource person and keynote speaker Dr. R.K. Uppal delivered his lecture on the preparation of research proposals and various funding agencies in social sciences providing financial support to carry out the research. He talked about the key points to be kept in mind while preparing research proposals like theme, objectives, introduction, budget preparation etc. He gave detailed description of the various funding agencies providing financial support for major and minor research projects like ICSSR, UGC, ILO, IIAS, IBA,ICAR, IIPA and many more. At the end of his deliberations, Dr. Uppal answered all the queries raised by the participants.



The lecture in the first technical session was delivered by Prof. Sanjeev Aggarwal focussing on the different types of research projects in Sciences and the funding agencies to carry these projects. The lecture was very motivating and full of inspiration. Prof. Aggarwal also discussed about the various fellowships, schemes like Women Scientist scheme – WOS-A & B, SERB, DRDO, ISRO, BARC, INSPIRE, DST, DAE, TIFR, NBHM etc. He lucidly explained the techniques to prepare research proposals and to prepare budget for them.



The last technical session was started after the lunch break by Dr Mani Shreshtha. His focus was to discuss the type of research projects and funding agencies supporting projects in Commerce and Management. He covered every aspect of preparation of research proposals and funding agencies in management like FICCI, ASSOCHAM, RBI, NIESBUD, PCRA, MNRE etc. Before the conclusion of the lecture and workshop, question-answer sessions were also arranged, and participants actively participated in this session.



Towards the end of the workshop, participants were asked to give their free and frank feedback on the workshop as per the prescribed feedback Performa supplied to them along with the workshop kit. The duly filled feedback Performa were handed over to the workshop coordinator for further analysis (Analysis of Feedback is given in Annexure I). In the valedictory session, the participants were distributed the participation certificate by the organizing committee. Dr. Pardeep Verma presented the crux of the workshop and thanked all the participants for making it a grand success. The workshop ended with the recitation of National Anthem.

Analysis and Interpretation





The feedback for the *Workshop Management* is tremendous and can be well evidenced with high altitude of **blue bar** in the graph which reflects the extremely satisfied outcome. If we take average of all the aspects together, this nearly comes to 80% of the respondents, considered as extremely satisfied and very satisfied for the purpose. This can be deduced by the graph that majority of the participants were academically enjoyed the workshop and as a host, we are well satisfied with the infrastructure we provided for the workshop and took pleasure of the organization of the workshop like this.

2. About Resource Person

2.1 Dr. R.K. Uppal for Arts/Humanities:



Dr. R.K.Uppal reciprocates a magnificent aptitude for the interactive session, as; his knowledge acquisition on the proposed topic was well planned and full of resourceful insight. Presentation of the topic, followed by effective execution, was commendable and so well his capacity was to handle queries that really set the stage for the audience. He was able to fascinate with his **Knowledge, Presentation, Effectiveness, Response** and **Interactions** with almost 75% of the respondents were **extremely satisfied** and **very satisfied** with the exception of 5% of the respondents which weights his performance in the **moderately satisfied** category. As far as statistical number is concerned, he has been responded 5 Points (**Extremely Satisfied**) by more than 60% of the respondents and 40% of the respondents responded 4 Points (**Very Satisfied**) in all the aspects which is considered here for the effectiveness of the resource person, which itself imply that he was tremendous speaker all through his presentation and covered useful material. Apart from his presentation effectiveness Dr. Mani was well established with the topic and was very affirm on his words, well selective and full of worthy improvements.

3. Overall Feedback

The average of **overall mean** score of the workshop is **4.73** and if we talk about the mode, **70%** have responded 5 and none of the participants responded 1 which shows that the majority of participants are extremely satisfied with all the aspects of arrangements, management of the Workshop and resourceful resource person.

A number of aspects have been included in the feedback form to assess the performance and benefits of the Workshop for the participants. So far as the responses of the participants for workshop Management, 65% of the respondents have shown full satisfaction by giving 5 out of 5 Points which represents the Excellent Management skills of the organizers.
